

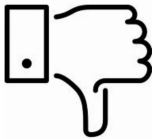

PA H.B. 38 JOINT RESOLUTION

Stifling our rights to elect appellate court judges and justices in PA

The PA Conference of Teamsters strongly opposes PA House Bill 38 Joint Resolution. This move, to amend the Pennsylvania Constitution to change the way we elect appellate court judges and justices in the Commonwealth, would erode our member's rights since electing appellate judges from districts gerrymandered by the General Assembly will make those judges increasingly beholden to partisan politics instead of the Pennsylvania Constitution and the laws of Pennsylvania.

Why after decades of electing appellate court judges and justices in the Commonwealth by voting for them statewide, would we need to change the constitution which would result in millions of Pennsylvanians being disenfranchised and having their voices silenced. By implementing House Bill 38 Joint Resolution, the Commonwealth would be stifling the rights of millions of Pennsylvanians from having the right to elect the judges of their choosing, as they have done so for many decades.
