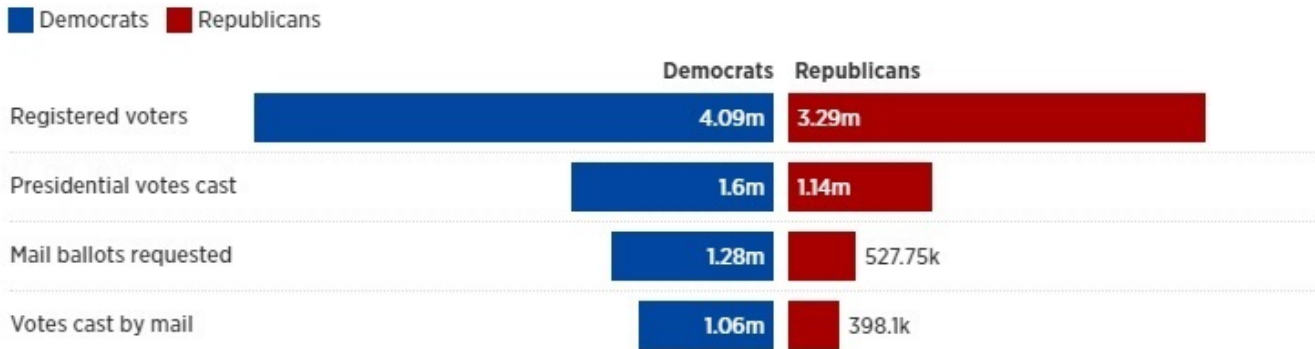

Overall, Democrats cast about 440,000 more votes for president than Republicans did in the June 2 contest, despite neither party having a competitive presidential primary.

Democrats Voted By Mail More Than Republicans Did

Registered Democrats outnumber Republicans and voted at a slightly higher rate in the June 2 primary election. There was a significant difference in how those votes were cast: About two out of three Democratic votes were cast by mail, compared with one out of three Republican votes.



Numbers are an estimate based on the mail ballots returned and votes cast for president. Real numbers will vary because of undervotes and a small number of ballots still to be counted.
