All 67 counties are still in “red,” the most stringent of the three phases, keeping all 12.8 million residents under stay-at-home orders and all non-life-sustaining businesses remaining closed.

“As conditions improve, counties and regions will have fewer restrictions, moving from red to yellow and, eventually, from yellow to green,” Wolf said.

When a region or county has average fewer than 50 new positive cases of the virus per 100,000 residents for 14 days, it can begin moving out from under his statewide lockdown.

The next phase, yellow, still bans gatherings of over 25 people, and gyms, casinos, theaters and other indoor recreational, wellness and entertainment venues will stay closed. Restaurants and bars will still be limited to carry-out or delivery, and businesses must follow federal and state guidance for social distancing and cleaning.
