Tech.pgh: Robots are coming to Pitt's campus to deliver food and Walmart to keep shelves stocked

A trip to Walmart is now even more likely to include a robot sighting. The massive retailer is expanding its partnership with Bossa Nova Robotics, a tech company with headquarters in the Strip District that makes robots to work in retail stores.

With 300 Bossa Nova robots already working in Walmart's aisles, the founders of the tech company say they have been a welcome addition to Walmart's staff — most stores give them their own name tag.

The University of Pittsburgh also is ramping up its robot game this week. After months of testing, the school officially deployed a fleet of 30 robots to act as a new food delivery service.

The robots, resembling knee-high coolers on wheels, take orders and deliver coffee, sandwiches, burritos, bagels and pretty much any other food and drink request to students on campus. Dorm munchies (and Oakland sidewalks) ma
