



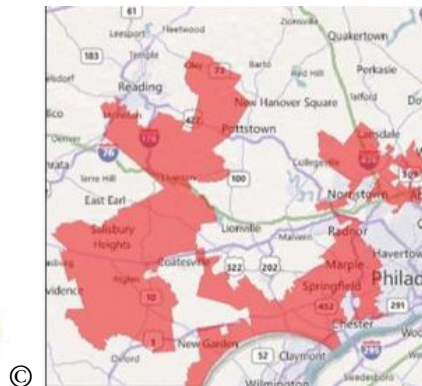
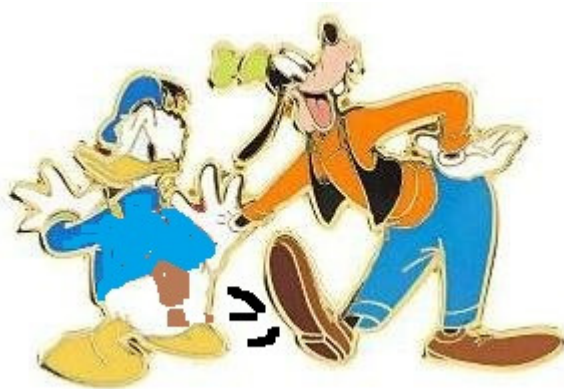

### Pa. Supreme Court strikes down state's Congressional district map

In an article posted on line by the Patriot News© "A split Pennsylvania Supreme Court has just thrown out the state's current map of Congressional districts, and ordered the legislature to submit new maps of the 18 districts by Feb. 9.

Then, Gov. Tom Wolf would have until Feb. 15 to approve or disapprove the new legislation setting out the House districts. The case only refers to the state's 18 seats in the U.S. House of Representatives.

That new map, barring some intervening stay by another court, would be used for this spring's primary election.

A majority on the seven-member court held, in its order, that the current maps created in 2011 "clearly, plainly and palpably violates" the state Constitution."
